How it Works

Families can shop at the pantry once a week. Families will be allowed inside one at a time to shop. Families should only send one person in to shop. Face masks are required anyone showing covid-like symptoms or is unvaccinated. Free delivery is available for anyone who is unable or uncomfortable coming inside to shop.

Who We Serve

We serve individuals and families who live in North Liberty and small towns in Johnson County including Oxford, Shueyville, Solon, Tiffin, etc.

What We Offer

Food & Toiletries:

Fresh bread, produce, and frozen foods, in addition to canned and packaged groceries. Families who live in our service area*, can come shop once per week. We also have a variety of toiletries, feminine hygiene products, and diapers.



Detergent:

Provided every two months.

Delivery:

Families can call (319) 519-6165 to request grocery delivery. After we receive their request, we will call the family to take their order and arrange a delivery time. Groceries are delivered on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday each week.

We are a community of neighbors helping neighbors and want to make your experience at the Pantry as pleasant as possible.

New Families

In order to use the pantry we ask families to provide us with the following information:

- Full Name
- Date of Birth
- Current Address
- Name and age of everyone in your household



* Our Service Area

In-area: Individuals and families who live in North Liberty, small towns (Oxford, Tiffin, Solon, Swisher, Shueyville, etc.), and rural areas in Johnson County.

Out-of-area: Individuals and families who live in Coralville, Iowa City, and outside of Johnson County.

Out-of-area families can receive sacked food once and a small amount of government commodities at future visits.

Additional Services

Growing Together Garden: This is an educational space for the entire community. We aim to offer educational activities throughout the year. Due to current circumstances, activities may be limited. Follow us on social media or check out our website to learn about any upcoming Growing Together Garden events.

Coat Distribution: We host an annual winter wear distribution in the fall. Adult and children's winter coats and a limited selection of other winter wear are available.

Free Pantry Farmers Market: Thursdays from 5PM-6PM, May through September, shoppers can pick up fresh produce in addition to groceries at the Pantry.

Clothing: Families in our service area can also visit the Community Closet. It is located in a separate building just steps away from the Pantry. We have a selection of adult, children, and infant clothing, as well as new socks and underwear. Families can get 5 items of clothing per family member every month and one package of socks and underwear for each family member every 4 months. It is open Monday through Thursday from 10AM-12PM and Tuesday and Thursday from 3PM-6PM.



Frequently asked questions

How often can I come to the pantry?

You can shop as often as once a week.

Do you offer services other than food?

We offer a limited selection of toiletries, diapers and baby formula. For other needs, we can refer you to other social service organizations in the area.

What if I can't get to the pantry?

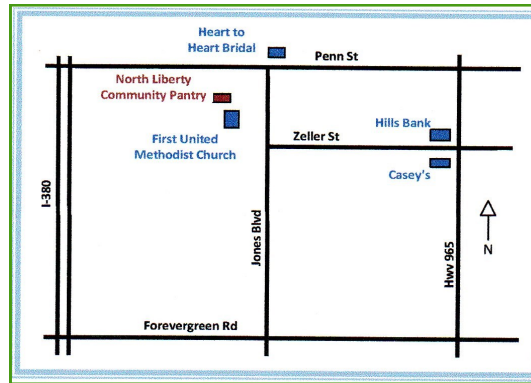
